- 1) Old Business no report
  - 2) New Business
    - a) Current Legislative Issues at State and National
      - i) The City is evaluating the recent USDOT letter from Secretary Duffy. The guidance from the letter is unclear at this time.
      - ii) The City received notification that the guidance issued in 2022 which provided rules around race and gender has been rescinded.
      - iii) House Bill 939 is of concern to the City because it revises building codes, and if passed it will have a significant impact to vertical construction projects.
  - 3) Department Updates (Introductions, Organizational & Staff Changes, Projects Report, etc.)
    - a) ARCHITECTURE
      - i) CMAR RFP for the detention center has been released.

ii) RFQ for the design of the Community Resource Center (CRC) will be coming out in the second or third quarter. The Center will provide mental health and drug abuse support services. The location and final budget are still being developed.

# b) AVIATION

- i) The department is hosting an outreach of upcoming design and construction projects on July 17<sup>th</sup>. It will be held at the Aviation Department Offices, 601 Brasilia Ave., Kansas City, MO 64153, 2nd Floor Conference Room from 1:30 pm 2:30 pm (It is recommended you arrive early to park, check-in and locate a seat) Contact Jade Liska with any questions.
- ii) Landside on-call RFQ for both airports is coming out this year. More details will be provided during the July 17<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- iii) There is a budget of \$15 to \$20 M in projects coming up in 2026-2028. Design will be completed by both on-call consultants and through RFQ selection.

# e) PUBLIC WORKS

- i) The city is working on a template for private development plans. The goal is for the plans to have similarities in content and format to improve efficiency by plan reviewers.
- ii) \$40 M Bridge Grant still waiting for agreement from the FHWA.
  - (1) An RFQ for an owner's rep will be released in May.
- iii) The upcoming projects have not changed from the last meeting.
- iv) Proposed improvements to 63<sup>rd</sup> Street (Woodland to Troost) is being combined with a Water services project in Daniel Boone Park. Funding is being evaluated including federal grants.
- v) Platte County and the City are discussing gas tax revenues and how that can be used on projects. It is estimated to be \$25M over 5 years.
- vi) Projects to improve transportation during the World Cup are as yet undefined.
- vii) The department appreciates any support from ACEC and the membership in promoting funding for local government projects. There is a lot of need that continues to be unfunded.
