- 2. MoDOT Staff Changes none
- 3. "State of MoDOT" Patrick joined us and shared with us an update on legislative, funding, STIP, I-70 Projects, I-44 Projects, capacity issues, and staffing:
  - a. I-70 Program going well; Project #1 Contract signed and under way; Project #2 (STL) draft RFP is out for comments; concerns with outside agencies ability to meet the schedule (SHPO in particular); were successful in the Federal Grant application process which will provide funding for additional improvements along the corridor; draft STIP at \$15M+ an all-time high; state budget includes \$700M in project funding for I-44 corridor (schedule dependent on Environmental Study completion/approvals); concerns with contractor capacity in Missouri; working with State tech to get equipment operators educated/trained; vacancies cut in half, but still struggling with engineering and maintenance areas; Longer term outlook EV: will impact funding stream so starting work with legislators (ACEC too)

#### 4. Consultant Related Issues:

- b. When Will There be an Updated MoDOT Consultant Services 6-Month Outlook? Jeff reported that once STIP is finalized should be able to get this out in June/July timeframe; also has asked Districts to provide 2 year staffing plan so should be able to expand 6 month outlook to 12 month outlook;
- c. Standard Contract Terms/Conditions ACEC comments being reviewed and MoDOT will provide an update to language for us to review in the near future
- d. Construction Phase Services Support still under review at District level, STL and KC Districts in particular

- 5. Software & User Group Issues
  - e. ORD Use Issues MoDOT ok with adding 1 or 2 ACEC representatives on their committee. Action: Chair/Board will need to determine how/who will participate and duration (one year like other committee assignments?)
  - f. Construction Phase Support Set up Users' Group? Need further discussion with Danica/MoDOT (agenda item for next meeting)
  - g. Any Updates on New Accounting Software for Tracking Payments/Implementation?
    - i. Still in implementation process.
    - ii. AASHTOware will DBE firms be required to pay \$1,000 per contract? If so, this is a major issue.
