BIOGRAPHY

Steve Wolff currently serves as the General Manager of the Southwestern Water Conservation District. The District is comprised of nine counties covering southwest Colorado. The District's statutory authority is to protect, conserve, use and develop the water resources of the Southwestern basin for the welfare of the District, and safeguard for Colorado all waters of the basin to which the state is entitled. Steve also serves as the Chair of the Upper Colorado River Commission's Engineering Committee

Prior to this position, Steve served as the Interstate Streams Division Administrator in the Wyoming State Engineer's Office. The Interstate Streams Division provides primary oversight for Wyoming's rights and responsibilities relative to the seven interstate water compacts and three interstate water decrees the State is signatory to. While in Wyoming, Steve also served as Chair of the Management Committee of the Upper Colorado River Endangered Fish Recovery Program.
