1. Introductions

Chip started the meeting by thanking everyone for attending. Introductions by attendees were then made.

2. MoDOT Leadership Updates / Key Initiatives

- Safety initiatives Pushing this omnibus safety package. No. 1 priority primary seatbelt, etc.
 - Work zones massive push lots of inspections in house looking at typical applications of these and how to make safer
 - Upcoming meetings unfunded needs meetings November 14 (Springfield),
 November 15th (Joplin)
 - Wrapping up a lot of construction projects a lot of active projects trying to get 9 structures completed this year, but have opened six so far
 - Are we ready for winter? Difficult to hire this time of year and have them up to speed for the winter. Been pursuing new staff for months. Big conversation point at the moment
 - o MoDOT not as well staffed as they were a year ago

3. District Updates / Staffing Changes - Issues / Concerns

- Steve Staffing
 - o Still trying to get upper-level staff
 - o new market rates have helped
 - o noticeable difference in turn over (less) than a year ago.
 - o 20th is the statewide drilling for trucks

- A lot of shifting of resources across boundaries; makes the drills all that more important
- John Down four employees (about 10%)
 - o March was the last new hire. Several advertisements, but no applicants
 - With the recent market adjustment MoDOT is seeing an uptake in applications
 - o May shuffle the consultant projects to make sure they are more balanced
- John T Authorized to 72, but down a little bit. about 12 down and have advertisements for six engineers, interviews this week.
 - o Slowly making ground, not quite ready to get to 72, but maybe stay at 66 for a bit
 - o CO allowed district to Advertise interns early
 - o MSU picnic for the engineers and got an intern from that event.
- Stacy 6 TPD's now, will help get through the consultant projects
 - o six project managers now
 - o a new designer starts on Monday.
 - o More interest moving forward.
 - o Can only fill so many positions. Not all of them.

4. Trends in Recent Solicitations

- Stacy Number of bids about two, maybe 2.6 average.
 - o Inflation too Starting to see that now, above program amounts. Material issues are still out there.
 - o Resurfacing and paint is higher and the delay
- Trends in recent solicitations
 - No. of responses see decreasing number of responses. apparent there are a lot of work on the streets. Need to list 3 firms or need to add advertisement
 - o Multiphase projects Phase 1 concept, Phase 2 prelim, final design, Phase 3 construction. More than 3 or 4 phases the project gets scrutinized
 - Centralized negotiation wanting to build a statewide database from the last five years to review and pull data from.
 - Independent Cost Estimate Tool (ICET) Review of the jobs the last five years. Tracking MoDOT internal projects too.
 - Trying to get away from construction cost % for design fees and get closer to a real-world cost from previous projects based on type.
 - Take PDF info from last contracts and digitize it to create the database.
 - Allow to take a more data driven approach to negotiations, costs per tasks vs. paying a premium
 - Timely fee Submittals
 - Getting the fee estimates in quickly helps the process along
 - Getting revisions from comments back in a timely manner also helps
 - Solicitation with 2 to 3 week fee negotiation window is working well.
 - Trying to speed up the process to get the next phase fee estimate back from the consultant
 - MOU fee negotiations are taking a longer timeframe than it should be

- Deadlines from MoDOT PM's help the consultant prioritize their work
- o ORD process & how is it going?
 - Some experience with it, but not all projects
 - District staff is working with ORD on some projects

5/6. Management of Six-Month Outlook / STIP and Unfunded Needs Status

- Six Month Outlook looking at the next release in November.
 - Best look at that moment in time.
 - Still looking to get experience for their staff too.
- Frank M New STIP last year under compressed time frame. More money to work with before inflation.
 - o Did more work on the system, first time in the rural areas (Joplin and Branson)
 - o 11 identified major project
 - Route 52 Railroad underpass in Butler County, FY 27
 - Joplin 7th Street corridor Route 66 with ADA, FY 24
 - Carthage Route 66 ADA project
 - Joplin 32nd street over RR overpass Scheduled for FY 27
 - Joplin realigning Davis blvd in FY 24
 - I-44 / 49 interchange improvements FY 26
 - Republic MM corridor projects FY 24 & 25
 - CC in Ozark intersections and Ozark has a cost share project
 - I-44 KS Expressway to Route 65
 - I-44 Route 13 interchange improvements
 - Webster County couple of interchanges FY 25 rail grant project
 - HW 60 ties into BNSF
 - Interchange at Diggins in 25
 - Another project in Seymour in FY 27 remove at grades, close some at grades, etc.
- Bud Ongoing work on US60 corridor, between Sunshine and Republic, widening and looking at a variety of intersections
 - James River Freeway ongoing
 - o I-44 and Route MM looking at roundabouts at 266 and acquiring ROW
 - o Kansas expressway widening too. ADA, etc.
- Drew US 60 project. New lanes and frontage roads between 65 and NN around the J interchange - fy27
- Unfunded needs
 - o Preparing a new list
 - First two tiers are done and working on third tier in MM
 - Nothing new or a surprise from the past list.

7. 2023-2025 On-Call Update/Discussion

- Solicitations are out, due back on November 15
- No more district categories, more statewide now

- List should be bigger
- Biggest category will be the roadway design
- Going to have at least one team for each category to rate the LOI and score them. Roadway may have two teams and will have district representation on each team
- MoDOT asked for help by spreading the word on the on-call solicitation
- MoDOT said they want to spread the opportunities around and that there is an equitable split
- Diversity statement can be included in the brochure instead of on each three page letter
- Need to include the cover letter with each three page letter and to specify the districts consultant wants to work in

8. Future Design Build Projects

As part of the upcoming projects Frank Miller mentioned these projects:

- Bridge Bundle potential design build not a "for sure" though. A lot of the bridges north of 44 FY25
- Potential for another I-44 DB

9. Consultant Deliverables – Quality/Areas of Improvement

- Simple mistakes where a qc review should have caught the errors
- Do a better job of QC on the plans
- MoDOT is considering a discussion on Quality control in the solicitation and scope of services
- Not meeting the MoDOT established deadline when specifically stated in the Scope of work
- Kristi doesn't mind reviewing at the same time as the consultant if the effort is made to inform the district. Prefer after qc review but if a time crunch maybe do a concurrent review
- Quality of field inspection too. Haven't heard any complaints on recently completed inspection projects
- At beginning of project, during concept, be part of design team and brainstorming process, so before the actual report. Also include traffic in this
- Some PM's like using the Bluebeam Revu feature, some don't
- Development side be the first point of contact between MoDOT and Developer
