Public Notice Now Open for Regulatory Impact Reports: 10 CSR 20-7.015 Effluent Regulations Regulatory Impact Report and 10 CSR 20-7.031 Water Quality Standards

A Regulatory Impact Report (RIR) for proposed revisions to 10 CSR 20-7.015, Effluent Regulations, and 10 CSR 20-7.031, Water Quality Standards, is now available for public comment. This report is required at the

beginning of the rulemaking process for rules prescribing environmental standards or conditions. It documents the environmental and economic costs and benefits associated with the proposed rule changes. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources welcomes your comments to help ensure that our regulations provide required protections but do not add unneeded costs.

Review and comment on these RIRs through the Department's Regulatory Action Tracking System, or RATS, webpage from September 23, 2022 through November 21, 2022 at this link: <https://apps5.mo.gov/proposed-rules/welcome.action#OPEN>.

Submit comments either online through RATS, by email to wqs@dnr.mo.gov, or by mail, Missouri Department of Natural Resources, ATTN: WQS, P.O. Box 176, Jefferson City, MO 65102-0176. Include your contact information: the rule number, your name, email address, and phone number.

Proposed revisions to the rules above will be open for public comment at a later date. Please confine your comments during this public notice to the RIRs only.
